Bruce Malone is a retired Dow Chemical researcher (17 patents – including materials used on the Space Station). He is an internationally known speaker and Executive Director of Search for the Truth Ministries. His latest book is *Censored Science – The Suppressed Evidence*.

Charles Morris became a Christian in his early teens and struggled with evolution, scripture, and history during his teens and early 20s. After earning a BSEE at Georgia Tech, he moved to MN where he spent most of his career in computer design and architecture. Shortly after moving to MN, he attended a night school class which began the process of opening his eyes to how science supports scripture rather than being in conflict with it. The subject of origins has been somewhere between a hobby and a passion ever since.

Ross S. Olson, MD is a retired pediatrician who spent 8 years as a missionary to Hong Kong. He struggled with his faith in college and medical school over the issue of evolution. He became a theistic evolutionist until years later he discovered that he had been brainwashed and “The Emperor Has No Clothes.”
